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Recommended vaccinations and tests by age
 By the American Academy of Pediatrics

Age	Immunization or Test
Birth	Hepatitis B Vaccine
2 months	Pentacel*, Hepatitis B, Prevnar, Rotateq
4 months	Pentacel, Prevnar, Rotateq
6 months	Pentacel, Hepatitis B, Prevnar, Rotateq
9 months	Check up only
12 months (1 year)	Varicella (chickenpox), MMR (measles, mumps, rubella) Hepatitis A is recommended at this time, but not required by the state of MS. CBC and Lead lab tests
15 months	Prevnar, Pentacel (combination of Dtap, Hib, and Polio)
18 months	Hepatitis A (recommended)
24 months (2 years)	CBC and Lead lab tests
30 months (2 and ½ years)	Check up with testing as advised by Practitioner
36 months (3 years)	Check up with testing as advised by Practitioner
4-6 years (School entry for MS)	DtaP, MMR, Varicella, IPV
11-12 years (Required to enter 7 th grade for MS)	Tdap
11 years and up	Gardasil (HPV) – when starting under 15 yrs old, series is 2 shots 6 months apart. Starting 15+ yrs series is 3 shots with second shot 2 months after the first and third shot 6 months after first.
11 years & up	Meningococcal vaccine
**Beginning at 6 months	Influenza shot annually (Oct – Dec)

* Pentacel is a combination vaccine which includes DtaP (Diphtheria, tetanus, and pertussis), Hib (Haemophilus influenzae type B), and Polio
